CURRICULUM & ELECTIVES

The middle school curriculum includes Language Arts, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science, and Bible. The electives are on a rotational schedule each quarter of the school year. The elective rotation includes Band, Show Choir, Intro to Spanish and French, Art, Technology, Drama, and Speech. In addition, to the elective rotation, all 7th grade students participate in Physical Education and Health throughout the entire school year. All 8th grade students have the option of participating in Physical Education or taking either Spanish or French for high school credit. All subjects are taught from a Biblical worldview.

HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT

In certain subjects, 8th grade students can earn high school credit. These subjects are French 1, Spanish 1, and Algebra 1.

ATHLETICS

EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT PROGRAM

Additional educational support programs are offered for students with a 504 or IEP and are available through our S.T.E.P. program. Our Accountability class allows students to work one-on-one with the Accountability teacher, to ensure proper study skills are being used.

CLUBS and EXTRA CURRICULAR

There are many different club offerings for middle school students. Some clubs are for middle school students only. These include our Art Club, Girls Bible Study, Student Council, Student Government Association, and National Junior Honor Society. Other clubs that our middle school students are able to participate in are the 6th-8th Engineering Club and 4th-12th Chess Club. In addition to the club options, our middle school student are able to audition for our spring musical production.

TESTING
