2025-2026 Registration, Tuition, and Fees

1. APPLICATION FEE* (Non-Refundable)

New Students Only – \$60 per student (paid online at enrollment)

2. ADMISSION TESTING – \$65.00 per student (Non-Refundable)

Admission/placement testing is required for all new students, Kindergarten through 8th grade, if the child has not taken a Standardize Achievement Test in the spring of the previous school year.

3. REGISTRATION FEE* (Non-Refundable)

New Student

\$250 per student (due upon acceptance) *

High School (9th & 10th)

\$150 per Student*

Returning Student

\$150 per student if paid before May 1st * (Due upon re-enrollment)

\$300 per student if paid on or after May 1st * (Due upon re-enrollment)

* Fees are Non-Refundable

4. TUITION & PROGRAM FEE

Program fees cover the costs for actual products, services, retreats, graduation expenses, etc. These fees go beyond the normal educational program and are often unique to that grade. **Program fees are due upon acceptance or prior to 1st day of school and only payable in the main office.**

Program fees are non-refundable and if not received reports cards will be held until payment is made.

5. FACTS Tuition Management

All families must enroll in FACTS for tuition and all recurring charges. Your registration will not be considered complete, until you have registered with FACTS. The cost for this program is based on the tuition payment schedule chosen. Payments will be drawn on either the 5th or 20th of the month.

NOTE: Grace offers multiple child discounts. The 2nd/3rd child will receive a 10% discount, 4th+ child will receive a 50% discount.



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6. BEFORE & AFTER CARE FEES

Please see the separate application, available at www.graceknights.org.

Before care opens at 6:30 AM.

After care includes all half days except where noted and closes at 6:00 PM.

Registration Fee: *\$35.00 per student (**Non-Refundable**)

Before Care: PK3-8th grade: \$215/month (August – May)

After Care: PK3-8th grade: \$320/month (August – May)

Before & After Care: PK3-8th grade: \$535/month (August – May)

NOTE: Grace offers multiple child discounts. The 2nd/3rd child will receive a 10% discount, 4th+ child will receive a 50% discount.

DROP-IN RATE:

Upon approval from the aftercare director the following fees apply to drop-in services and are due upon arrival or pickup:

\$25 before care

\$35 aftercare

\$60 half-day aftercare

- Early arrival / Late Pick-up Fees:

A charge of \$10.00 for each 15 minutes or portion thereof, per child, is assessed if a child is dropped off early or is picked up late.

7. ATHLETIC FEE

This fee is due at the beginning of each season for all sports including Cheerleading.

Middle School \$80 per student, per sport.

8. MISCELLANEOUS FEES

-Returned Check Fee: \$35

-Withdrawal Fee \$150

Full tuition and fees of the month in which the child withdraws and 100% of remaining tuition balance unless the school board deems the withdrawal legitimate (such as moving out of the area).

-Late Payment Fees

5% on outstanding tuition and on any other charges over 30 days.
