
#### **GCA Athletics**

# DRESS CODE

Now that school is in full swing, please take the time to remind yourself and your student of GCA's student dress code.

- All hair should be a natural color. Please begin to plan for girls to have only natural hair colors (no pinks, purples, blues, etc).
- Bottoms are to be an approved school uniform bottom.
   No jeggings or cargo pants allowed. Pants should not be skin tight.
- All students are to have on a school uniform top (a navy or white polo), even if they are wearing a GCA hoodie, sweatshirt.
- Crocs are not an approved shoe at GCA.

Students will first receive a verbal notice of any infraction. A second infraction will result in parent contact and the student will either be given a new article of clothing to wear or a parent will be called to bring appropriate clothing.

### **GCA's Updated Mask Policy**

Greetings GCA Parents and Guardians,

Based on the latest guidelines released by the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and the recent vote by the Maryland State Board of Education on February 22, 2022, this morning, March 1, 2022, the GCA Board voted unanimously to end the mask mandate here at Grace Christian Academy effective immediately. Beginning Wednesday, March 2, 2022, Grace Christian will no longer require masks and the use of masks is optional for students, staff and visitors who enter our building and grounds.

This means that staff, students and visitors may continue to wear masks to Grace if they so choose. We ask parents to speak with their child about wearing a mask and respecting others who choose not to do so as Grace will not enforce mask usage among students. You are encourage to make masking decisions that best suit your child and your family. Please note that the CDC, along with the state and local health authorities, still recommends regular mask use for those who are medically compromised or unvaccinated for COVID-19.

Grace will continue the following mitigating measures:

- 1. Use of our Fever Free App parents/students will continue to use the app daily with a successful clearance before students will be allowed to enter the building.
- 2. Have students stay home if sick please continue to use the Healthnotes@graceknights.org to report students illnesses and testing results.
- 3. Use of hand sanitizer is available in every room and throughout the building.
- 4. Continue to follow the CDC's guidance for staff and students who may test positive for COVID

Since Grace is moving to masks as an option versus a requirement, we are focusing on returning to standard operations for our school in the near future. This has been what seems like an eternity, but with God's help, we will continue to move forward and begin to operate in this new normal for education. Please continue to pray for the health and well-being of our community as our focus is still on the health and safety of our students and staff.
