




## **Spirit Shirt Fridays**




We know that some parents are waiting for uniforms to arrive in the mail or be returned to the school with the school logo. Grace will be extended the first few weeks of school. However, when you are purchasing uniform bottoms please be aware of GCA uniform guidelines. A school uniform pant has a 'welt' pocket, not a *pocket on the outside*. Girls are **not** to wear *jegging style* or *stretchy pants* that are khaki or navy in color. We will be enforcing our dress code soon and will send parents an email if their child is out of dress code. *This goes for all students*. Many girls are wearing stretchy material pants. *Cargo shorts* are not a school uniform bottom. Below are pictures of approved pants/shorts. ## Want to celebrate your student's birthday at school? Treats such as cupcakes or cookies are allowed and must abide by the following:

- A notice must be made to the homeroom teacher a week in advance to include what will be brought in and when.
- The homeroom teacher will email a notice out to parents of what is being brought in and when. If your student is not allowed to consume the birthday treats, please notify the teacher.
- All food and/or drinks MUST be SEALED from a STORE AND MUST have a NUT FREE Label.
- All food/drinks must be brought to the office, not given to the teacher directly or sent in with the student.
- NO balloons or treat bags. The school cannot be held responsible for any items that may contain an allergen in a treat bag, nor can we search each bag that is brought in.

If your student has allergies or diet restrictions such as nuts, dairy, eggs, soy, wheat, vegan, etc. You may send in a separate treat with your child to be enjoyed on that day.

# TARDY!

Student tardies are becoming very frequent. Please review the school's tardy policy from our handbook. Student tardies to school and to classes can and will effect their enrollment at Grace and their class averages. We need your help in getting students to school on time.

### ATTENDANCE

Good attendance and punctuality are not only critical to the overall academic success of students, they are also important for the development of personal responsibility. Not only is the absent or tardy affected, but the teacher and the entire class may be affected by the need for adjusted instruction. Please join with us in training your child to possess these qualities.

- Students are expected to be in school every day that school is in session. If
  a student is absent twenty (20) days during the year, the school may either
  retain or not allow the student to return the following year. A student who
  achieves passing grades will be promoted if the parents withdraw and place
  their child in another school. Absences due to extenuating circumstances,
  such as extended illnesses, will not apply if the parents keep in constant
  communication with appropriate school personnel and provide the school
  with necessary medical documentation.
- An elementary student who has a total of forty (40) tardies to school (excused and unexcused) may not be permitted to return to Grace Christian Academy. Students will be counted as on time if they are with their teacher by the start time. Students leaving before 2:00 p.m. shall be credited with one-half day in attendance.

#### Unexcused Tardy to Class (Middle School)

Students are expected to be in their seats, ready to work at the start of the period. Students who fail to reach their next class period during the allotted time without a valid pass, note from teacher, or note from office, will be unexcused tardy. The student should not argue with the teacher or try to explain the tardiness. One point will be deducted from the student overall class average at the end of the quarter for every 3 unexcused tardies to class.

## **Note From the Nurse**

#### Did you receive an email from the nurse?

If you have received an email from the nurse requesting health documents such as updated vaccine records, health inventory, blood lead results, medications, etc. please accomplish these requests ASAP. It important to ensure your child's record is up to date as we prepare for an inspection from the Health Department.

#### **Vaccines Requirements:**

- 7th Grade (must be 11 yrs old to receive): Meningococcal, Tdap
- Kindergarten: Second dose of MMR & Varicella
- Pre-K3 & Pre-K4: DTaP/DTP/DT (4 Doses) Polio (3 Doses) Hib (at least 1 dose

given after 10 mos of age) MMR (at least 1 dose) Varicella (at least 1 dose)

Hepatitis B (3 doses) PCV (1 dose). If your child turns 5 within the school

year, the second MMR dose is required within 20 days of their birthdate.

#### **Medications:**

New medication authorization forms are required for this school year. The front desk WILL NOT accept medications without the proper forms. There is a general form and one specifically for students with allergies/anaphylaxis and/or asthma. All forms are found in Parents Web, under the Admissions tab on our website, or at the school office.

#### **COVID-19 Guidance:**

As many of you know, COVID-19 seems to be on the rise again. Per MSDE guidance your child should complete a 5 day isolation period following a positive COVID-19 test. Day 0 is considered the day symptoms started in symptomatic persons or the day of the positive test if asymptomatic. After day 5, if your child has no symptoms OR if symptoms are improved and they have had no fever for at least 24hrs without medication, they may return to school if they wear a well-fitting mask for 5 additional days (day 6-day10).

If they are unable to wear a mask, they may return if they have a negative test at day 5 or later. These test results must be provided to the school via <u>healthnotes@graceknights.org</u>. Otherwise, they should remain at home for day 6-day 10.

Parents are required per the Department of Health to report all positive at home COVID tests at <u>onestop.md.gov</u>
