

SCHOOL UNIFORMS

We are almost midway through the first quarter so all students should have their school uniforms by now. We have been lenient the first few weeks as many students/parents expressed they were waiting on items to arrive in the mail. However, many students are not wearing appropriate pants to school. A school uniform pant has a 'welt' pocket, not a pocket on the outside. Girls are not to wear jegging style or stretchy pants that are khaki or navy in color. We will be enforcing our dress code next week and will send parents an email if their child is out of dress code. This goes for elementary students too. Many girls are wearing stretchy material pants. Cargo shorts are not a school uniform bottom. Below are pictures of approved pants/shorts. Parents, cold & flu season is here as well as back to school "bugs" please be
mindful of the following. Please be aware that any student requiring the use of
medication must have a medication administration form signed by their provider
and parent on file for each medication. Medications must be brought in to school
un-opened and in the original packaging. Medications will not be accepted without
a medication administration form. Medications must be turned in by a parent, not
the student.

COVID Guidelines

- When a child becomes ill at school, a mask is recommended and can be provided.
 Depending on symptoms and condition of child, parents will be called to pick-up their child.
- Current MSDE guidance recommends COVID-19 testing should a student/staff member develop symptoms
- Currently the school has a supply of COVID-19 tests that can be sent home with a symptomatic child to be completed at home
 - If test is negative, student may return when symptoms are improved and no fever
- for 24 hours without medication
 - A student or staff member who tests positive for COVID-19 should complete a 5
- day isolation at home from the date symptoms start. Day 0 is considered the day symptoms start or the day of the positive test.
 - After day 5, if the person has no symptoms or symptoms have improved and no
- fever for 24hrs without medication, they may return to school if they wear a wellfitting mask for 5 additional days (day 6-10)
 - If they are unable to wear a mask, they may return if they have a negative test at
- day 5 or later.

Illness & Injury

- Please review and become familiar with the Parent/Student manual
- Children will be required to be sent home for temperatures 100 degrees or higher,
- vomiting, diarrhea (2 or more episodes), very frequent cough, any communicable disease listed by the State of Maryland
 - Students who are ill should be picked-up within an hour of parental notification.
- Students may return to school if fever free for 24 hours without use of medication,
- vomiting & diarrhea free for 24 hours
